The Citadel Fixed Income & Macro Central Bank Challenge Terms and Conditions

These program terms ("terms") govern your application to the Citadel Fixed Income & Macro Central Bank Challenge ("Program"). By applying for the Program, you agree to these terms. If any of these terms are not complied with, Program consideration and any resulting offer may be forfeited in Citadel's sole discretion.

What is the Citadel Fixed Income & Macro Central Bank Challenge?

The Citadel Fixed Income & Macro Central Bank Challenge is a program run by Citadel Americas Services LLC ("**Citadel**") that offers university sophomores the opportunity to compete on four-person teams in a two-day economic challenge ("**Competition**") at a venue in New York City, while receiving an introduction to Citadel Fixed Income & Macro. If selected to participate in the Program, students must be available to attend the Program from April 1, 2025 to April 3, 2025 in New York City.

Who is eligible?

Individuals that meet the following requirements may apply to the Program:

- You must be an undergraduate at a college or university in the United States or Canada in good standing currently pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Physics, Computer Science, or another highly quantitative field who will graduate between December 2026 June 2028.
- Employees, officers, directors, members, managers, agents, consultants and representatives of Citadel Americas Services LLC and its affiliates are not eligible.

As a condition of participation, each participant agrees to provide Citadel with any and all requested documentation or other proof of eligibility within the specified timeframe. Citadel reserves the right to disqualify at any time any applicant or potential participant who does not meet the eligibility criteria described in this section or has otherwise violated these terms, even if they have been offered a spot in the Program. There is a limit of one (1) application per individual for the Program.

As a condition of applying, you hereby agree to read, complete, agree to, and sign additional documentation that, among other things, provides information for tax and legal compliance purposes, grants Citadel certain licenses, and confirms the requirements and conditions for Program participation, including the rules for the Competition, if selected as a Program participant. This may include additional releases and documentation to provide travel and accommodations for Program attendance.

What is the application and selection process?

Applicants must submit their completed application between January 15, 2025 at 10:00AM ET and February 12, 2025 at 11:59PM ET. To apply, an individual can access the application on the Citadel website located <u>here</u> and follow the onscreen links and <u>instructions</u> to complete and submit the Program application form and provide all required information, which may include information about you, a resume, representative work experience, personal information such as first and last name and email address and contact information for the individuals who would participate as your teammates in the Program ("Applicant Content"). Participants are encouraged to apply with three other teammates, but will still be considered if an applicant does not apply as part of a full team. Your Applicant Content must be truthful and accurate and you must provide all required information or your application will not be considered. You may not use any content, data, information, strategies, inputs, or outputs generated by any generative artificial intelligence tools, including but not limited to tools and models like ChatGPT, OpenAI models like GPT-4, GitHub Copilot, and Vertex AI, to prepare your Applicant Content. Basic word processing features like grammar check are permissible to use, but you may not use generative AI features like Copilot in Word to develop your Applicant Content.

You are solely responsible for complying with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, or regulations in connection with your application for the Program. Proof of application (such as a screenshot of your application) does not constitute proof of actual receipt. Applications will not be returned. Keep a copy of each element of your application. Applications that are incomplete, illegible, corrupted, damaged, destroyed, altered, false, lost, late, misdirected, garbled or otherwise not in compliance with these terms will not be accepted and will be void.

Following the application submission deadline, Citadel's hiring committee will select up to ten (10) teams to participate in the Program based upon each team's academic performance, qualifications and demonstrated interest in the investment field.

What are the requirements for a participant's teammates?

Students must participate in the Program in teams of four. During the application process, applicants will be asked to identify the individuals who would participate in the Program as the applicant's teammates. All teammates will be evaluated by Citadel's hiring committee, and each teammate must meet all Program eligibility requirements and be in compliance with these terms. All potential teammates must independently submit an application for the Program during the application submission period and meet the Program eligibility requirements to be considered for participation in the Program. If an applicant does not indicate teammates in their application or does not otherwise have a full team of four to participate, Citadel will attempt to match applicants to form teams in connection with its evaluation of Program applicants. Where distinction is not necessary, selected applicants and teammates are referred to as "participants." Applicants represent and warrant that they have permission from their proposed teammates to provide the teammates' contact information to Citadel during the application process.

What are the Program benefits?

Program participants will each receive roundtrip economy-class airfare from an airport near participant's home in the continental United States or Canada to New York City, ground transportation to and from the New York airport, single occupancy hotel accommodations and meals per day for the duration of the Program. Participants will also receive a stipend to further offset living expenses during the Program and any tax obligations. Stipend amount will be determined in Citadel's sole discretion. The total value of Program benefits is approximately \$4,000.00. Any taxes (federal, state and local) and other costs and expenses associated with the Program benefits will be the sole responsibility of the participant and Citadel make no representation that the stipend will adequately cover individual participants' tax obligations. All Program benefits are subject to these terms and any specifics not set forth in these terms including Program stipend amount, will be determined in Citadel's sole discretion. Timing and manner for payment of the Program stipend will be determined by Citadel.

What are the Program expectations?

Participants are expected to attend all scheduled Program activities. During the Program, participants will compete in teams in the Challenge for the opportunity to win prizes, with the Challenge subject to separate Official Rules to be provided during the participant notification and confirmation process.

It is each participant's sole responsibility to comply with all travel requirements, which may include, without limitation, presenting a valid passport, visa and/or other necessary identification (including photograph) at the time of travel. As a condition of Program participant, all participants agree to maintain their behavior in accordance with all applicable laws and generally accepted social practices in connection with participation in any Program-related activity. Each participant understands and agrees that Citadel has the right, in its sole discretion, to remove a participant at any time from a Program event or the Program entirely if the participant's behavior at any point is uncooperative, disruptive, or may or does cause damage to person, property, or the reputation of Citadel and in such a case, the participant will still be solely responsible for all taxes and other expenses related to Program benefits.

You may not use any content, data, information, strategies, inputs, or outputs generated by any generative artificial intelligence tools, including but not limited to tools and models like ChatGPT, OpenAI models like GPT-4, GitHub Copilot, and Vertex AI for Program participation, unless explicitly instructed by the written prompt to do so. When will applicants be notified?

Once the evaluation is completed, a Program representative will attempt to notify the potential participants via telephone or email around the week of February 24, 2025. Potential participants will be required to respond to Citadel's notifications, provide required information and complete required paperwork in accordance with Citadel's instructions and stated deadlines to remain eligible for the Program.

General Rules

By applying for and/or participating in the Program (except where prohibited by law), you grant Citadel the irrevocable, sublicensable, perpetual right and permission to use, publish, post or display your name, Applicant Content, likeness, biographical and education information, any quotes attributable to you, any other indicia of persona, for purposes of

administering and promoting the Program without further obligation or compensation of any kind to you, anywhere, in any medium now known or hereafter discovered or devised, world-wide and you release Citadel and anyone authorized by Citadel from any and all liability related thereto. Nothing contained in these terms obligates Citadel to make use of any of these rights and you waive any right to inspect or approve any such use.

You agree to not damage or cause interruption of the Program application process and/or prevent others from applying to the Program. Citadel reserves the right to restrict or void participation from any IP address, email address or domain, device, or other designator or identifiable source if Citadel suspects any fraudulent or harmful participation. If Citadel determines at any time in its sole discretion that a participant is disqualified, ineligible, or in violation of these terms, Citadel may select an alternate participant. Citadel reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, modify or suspend the Program for any reason.

In the event there is an alleged or actual ambiguity, discrepancy, or inconsistency between disclosures or statements contained in any Program-related materials and these terms (including any alleged discrepancy or inconsistency within these terms), it will be resolved by Citadel. Citadel's failure to or decision not to enforce any provision in these terms will not constitute a waiver of that or any other provision.

Limitation of Liability, Release and Disclaimers

Disputes/Governing Law

These terms, the Program application and selection process, and any disputes related thereto, will be subject to confidential mandatory mediation and, if unsuccessful, confidential binding arbitration in Miami, Florida, both under the AAA rules. These terms will be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the Federal Arbitration Act. To the extent that state law is applicable, the parties agree that they will be interpreted, enforced and/or governed according to the laws of the State of Florida (without regard to conflict of law principles).
